The five-year projection for the population in the area is 31,388 representing a change of 0.28% annually from 2022 to 2027. Currently, the population is 49.3% male and 50.7% female.

Currently, 58.8% of the 12,296 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 35.5%, renter occupied; and 5.7% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.2% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.8% are renter occupied; and 10.0% are vacant. In 2020, there were 12,102 housing units in the area and 5.6% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.71%. Median home value in the area is \$170,983, compared to a median home value of \$283,272 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.95% annually to \$188,288.
