## Households by Income

Current median household income is \$77,546 in the area, compared to \$72,414 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$98,413 in five years, compared to \$84,445 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$120,895 in this area, compared to \$105,029 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$144,175 in five years, compared to \$122,155 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$56,445 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$40,363. The per capita income is projected to be \$67,614 in five years, compared to \$47,064 for all U.S. households

Currently, 38.8% of the 189,365 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 48.9%, renter occupied; and 12.3% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.2% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.8% are renter occupied; and 10.0% are vacant. In 2020, there were 181,651 housing units in the area and 11.9% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 1.87%. Median home value in the area is \$398,565, compared to a median home value of \$283,272 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.23% annually to \$467,180.
