The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 58.2 in the identified area, compared to 72.1 for the U.S. as a whole.

The number of families in the current year is 7,447 in the specified area.

Current average household income is \$118,606 in this area, compared to \$107,008 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$132,524 in five years, compared to \$122,048 for all U.S. households

Currently, 59.4% of the 13,620 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 18.8%, renter occupied; and 21.8% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.7% are renter occupied; and 9.8% are vacant. In 2020, there were 12,692 housing units in the area and 22.0% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 2.20%. Median home value in the area is \$347,578, compared to a median home value of \$308,943 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.85% annually to \$380,896.

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
