Currently, 37.8% of the 33,106 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 54.3%, renter occupied; and 7.9% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.7% are renter occupied; and 9.8% are vacant. In 2020, there were 32,399 housing units in the area and 8.1% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.67%. Median home value in the area is \$252,621, compared to a median home value of \$308,943 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.62% annually to \$273,714.
