Currently, 65.1% of the 102,912 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 29.7%, renter occupied; and 5.2% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.7% are renter occupied; and 9.8% are vacant. In 2020, there were 101,583 housing units in the area and 5.4% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.40%. Median home value in the area is \$229,237, compared to a median home value of \$308,943 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.92% annually to \$264,741.
