The five-year projection for the population in the area is 225,398 representing a change of 1.30% annually from 2019 to 2024. Currently, the population is 49.6% male and 50.4% female.

Current median household income is \$71,757 in the area, compared to \$60,548 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$82,434 in five years, compared to \$69,180 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$112,709 in this area, compared to \$87,398 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$125,222 in five years, compared to \$99,638 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$49,323 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$33,028. The per capita income is projected to be \$54,783 in five years, compared to \$36,530 for all U.S. households

Currently, 41.0% of the 101,900 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 50.0%, renter occupied; and 8.9% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.4% are renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. In 2010, there were 92,686 housing units in the area - 42.1% owner occupied, 46.5% renter occupied, and 11.3% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 4.30%. Median home value in the area is \$383,014, compared to a median home value of \$234,154 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.28% annually to \$428,626.
