Current median household income is \$102,965 in the area, compared to \$79,068 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$116,519 in five years, compared to \$91,442 all U.S. households.

Current average household income is \$157,211 in this area, compared to \$113,185 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$177,712 in five years, compared to \$130,581 for all U.S. households.

Current per capita income is \$71,818 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$43,829. The per capita income is projected to be \$82,321 in five years, compared to \$51,203 for all U.S. households.

Currently, 46.0% of the 109,564 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 47.0%, renter occupied; and 7.0% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 57.9% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.1% are renter occupied; and 10.0% are vacant. In 2020, there were 104,120 housing units in the area and 7.2% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 1.21%. Median home value in the area is \$563,059, compared to a median home value of \$355,577 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.07% annually to \$623,877.
