Current average household income is \$76,917 in this area, compared to \$90,054 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$84,828 in five years, compared to \$99,510 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$26,426 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$34,136. The per capita income is projected to be \$29,140 in five years, compared to \$37,691 for all U.S. households

Currently, 63.3% of the 33,932 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 29.9%, renter occupied; and 6.9% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.3% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 32,066 housing units in the area - 65.1% owner occupied, 25.6% renter occupied, and 9.3% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.55%. Median home value in the area is \$166,184, compared to a median home value of \$235,127 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.52% annually to \$179,162.
