Current median household income is \$94,333 in the area, compared to \$79,068 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$107,030 in five years, compared to \$91,442 all U.S. households.

Current average household income is \$118,701 in this area, compared to \$113,185 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$137,126 in five years, compared to \$130,581 for all U.S. households.

Current per capita income is \$44,845 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$43,829. The per capita income is projected to be \$52,271 in five years, compared to \$51,203 for all U.S. households.

Currently, 64.0% of the 81,779 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 30.9%, renter occupied; and 5.1% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 57.9% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.1% are renter occupied; and 10.0% are vacant. In 2020, there were 77,431 housing units in the area and 5.3% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 1.29%. Median home value in the area is \$376,533, compared to a median home value of \$355,577 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.46% annually to \$425,118.
